AND
- Be studying - or preparing to study - for an information science, information management, or librarianship qualification

OR

- Identify as BAME
AND
- Be working in a library or studying/preparing to studying an information science, information management, or librarianship qualification

To apply for one of the awarded places, please send a justification (no longer than 200 words in length) explaining why you think you would find attendance at the conference beneficial to your professional development. Following the conference the successful applicants will be required to write a short report on the conference for the Northern Collaboration which will be used for publication. Please also include your job title and the name of your institution.

Applications must be received by 5pm on 9th August. Successful applicants will be notified by mid August.
